



Public Art and Design 2016 projects

1. The City of Marion - \$4,500 Project Seed funding towards artist fees (3 x \$1,500) for artists to develop concepts for the *Hendrie Street Reserve Inclusive Play Space Public Art Project*. This project is part of the City of Marion's 1.6-hectare Hendrie Street Reserve redevelopment.
2. Royal Agricultural and Horticultural Society of South Australia - \$10,000 Commission Support funding towards the mural project *Littleartprojects618 at the Royal Adelaide Show*. The project partners, the Royal Adelaide Show and Littleartprojects618 to deliver a 100 meter mural along Goodwood Road.
3. The City of Port Adelaide Enfield - \$15,000 Project Seed funding towards artist fees (3 x \$5,000) for artists or artist teams to develop concept design proposals for the *Parks Library and Community Facility Public Artworks project*. This project is part of the State Government and City of Port Adelaide Enfield's redevelopment of the Parks Community Centre.
4. The City of Tea Tree Gully - \$15,000 Project Seed funding towards the fees for three (3 x \$5,000) established South Australian artist working in the field of public art to participate as mentors in the *IGNITE Artist Incubator* project.
5. The City of Marion - \$10,000 Commission Support funding towards the *Hendrie Street Reserve Inclusive Play Space* artwork *Dig and Delve* by artists Laura Will and Will Cheesman.
6. Country Arts SA - \$10,000 Commission Support funding towards the *Limestone Coast residency and video commission*. Video and performance artist Heat Franco will be based in Mount Gambier to mentor and work with Limestone Coast artists to produce new video works for public display.
